Dr Simone Matousek is a fully qualified Plastic, Reconstructive and Cosmetic Surgeon. Following her training through the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons, Dr Matousek completed two further fellowships, one in breast surgery, (Australasian Society of Aesthetic Plastic Surgeons/Allergan Breast Fellowship) and the other in facial aesthetic surgery (Mentor International Aesthetic Surgery Fellowship, London). Finding Us:

Dr Simone works within the grounds of St Luke's Private Hospital, Potts Point, in Hemsley House.

Directions:

Please note Roslyn St is a one-way street. Turn left down the driveway marked 'St Luke's Private Hospital'. There is free onsite parking in the visitor parking area. If the car park is full, there is paid car park (Wilson Parking) on Ward Avenue, and also 1 hour parking on the street. Hemsley House is a sandstone building opposite the main hospital. We are on level 1.



Coming by public transport:

The closest train station is Kings Cross Station, about a 5 minute walk from our practice. Upon exiting the station, walk along Darlinghurst road (in the opposite direction to the Coke sign) until you reach the first cross street on the right, which is Roslyn St. Continue along Roslyn St, crossing Ward Ave. Walk a few meters past the driveway marked 'St Luke's Private Hospital' until you see a green gate and signs for St Luke's Clinic. Enter through the gate and glass doors. Our office will be to your right.

Your consultation:

You will be seen for a consultation to assess your skin lesion and discuss surgical options. Small lesions can be done in the rooms under local anaesthetic (this can be requested on the same day as the consultation or another day). If it is larger it may need to be done in hospital as a day procedure.

Expected Costs:

The consultation fee is \$150; you will get a rebate from Medicare.

For rooms procedures, we estimate a total of \$450 out of pocket per lesion (including the consult fee). For hospital procedures, if you have private health insurance, you will be no-gapped for your surgery. The only additional expenses will be your hospital excess, if you have one.

Your follow up:

All immediate follow up is free of charge. You will be seen at around one week for removal of stitches and dressings. A further appointment is usually made to assess how your scar is progressing and if this needs any further attention.
